160 AMATEUR PLAYERS COMPETE IN BDB MASTERS & CHARITY GOLF 2024

JITRA – The BDB Masters & Charity Golf 2024 tournament concluded successfully, attracting a total of 160 participants over the three-day event held at Darulaman Golf & Country Club (DGCC), Kedah.

“A highlight was the "Hole-In-One" challenge, offering two cars: Proton X50 and Proton S70 worth more than RM180,000.00 with participants having two chances to win on the second and third days,”

The 2024 BDB Masters & Charity Golf Championship concluded at the Darulaman Golf & Country Club (DGCC), with Muhammad Farez Mohd Azihan, 24 emerged as the overall champion, finishing the three-day tournament with an impressive total of 214 strokes. He outperformed his closest competitors, Nor Haqem Nor Hadi and Shakiran Johari, who both completed the tournament with 217 strokes.

As champion, Muhammad Farez received a cash prize of RM2,800 and the championship trophy, presented by Raja Shahreen.

The tournament was also attended by the Chairman of BDB Darulaman Golf Resort Berhad, Dato' Haji Abdul Rahman Abdullah, along with the senior management team of BDB.

At the same event, Raja Shahreen announced that 10 schools had been selected to receive donations worth RM10,000.00, collected during the BDB Masters & Charity Golf 2024 tournament.

He stated that the donations were collected during the charity match and would be distributed to selected schools in Kedah.
